Community Programs

Our individualised support services build essential life skills and independence, enhance well-being, and encourage social interaction. These programs offer a range of educational and fun activities to provide choice, and meet individual goals and interests.



Supported Employment

Everyone deserves to be employed and feel valued at work. We provide a supportive environment where people living with disability can develop their unique skills, connect with a workplace community, and achieve financial independence.



Respite Care

We provide short term respite care at Shorter House, our facility in Traralgon which is the perfect place to unwind and relax for family and carers to provide time away for people who need a break, rejuvenate or a short stay away.



To ensure your wishes are carried out exactly as you intend, we recommend you seek professional advice from a solicitor when it comes to preparing your Will. The most common types of bequests include the following:

Residual bequests are a gift of the whole, or a percentage of the remainder of your estate after all your other wishes have been fulfilled and expenses met – for example, “I give 20% of my residual estate to Connecting2Ability.” As the value rises with inflation it will retain the same value in the future.

Pecuniary bequests are usually specific sums of money – for example, “I give \$10,000 to Connecting2Ability.”

Specific bequests are gifts of items of value, like property, artwork or shares.

Please discuss these options with your solicitor. They will ensure your family, friends and the charities you support will benefit as per your wishes. Whatever amount you choose to bequeath, your generosity will have an ongoing reach for those in need.

How Do I Leave a Gift in My Will?

STEP 1. DECIDE ON YOUR GIFT

We recommend consulting a solicitor, or using our FREE charity Will service EveryWill. You can choose leave:



A percentage of your estate (e.g. 10%). This ensures the value of your gift is realised over time keeping in line with inflation.



A particular asset (e.g. property, shares, valuables)



A specific amount (e.g. \$10,000)



The residue of your estate (what remains after other gifts and expenses are settled)

STEP 2. USE THE CORRECT WORDING

To include Connecting2Ability in your Will, you may wish to consider the following clauses:

"I give and bequeath to Connecting2Ability ABN 67 877 349 510 the sum of \$[amount] / [percentage]% of my estate / the residue of my estate, to be used for its general purposes. A receipt from an authorised officer of Connecting2Ability will be sufficient to show my executors have fulfilled their duty."

STEP 3. WRITE YOUR WILL

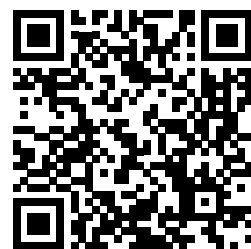

- Expert support and guidance are available throughout the process, and EveryWill will help you to think through everything you need to consider.
- If you need legal advice, ask. EveryWill will transfer you to a local solicitor to agree on a price to complete the Will you have started.
- Once you have finished, you simply download your Will and follow the instructions to have it signed and witnessed.
- Anyone over 18 can use this straightforward and convenient service.
